CERTIFICATE OF EXCELLENCE IN ASSESSMENT

COURSE OVERVIEW

This one day practical course will focus on the therapist's ability to assess and treat joint stiffness, tendinopathies and carpal tunnel at the wrist. Specific mobilization techniques for the carpal bones will be taught in detail, as well as self mobilizations techniques which can be used as home exercises. Evidenced based strength testing and strengthening strategies will be reviewed for tendinopathies. The course is designed to challenge the therapist's clinical reasoning skills, and the knowledge gained will be easy for the therapist to apply to clinical practice right away.
