

SACROILIAC JOINT MOBILIZATIONS

CERTIFICATE OF EXCELLENCE IN ASSESSMENT

COURSE OVERVIEW

This one day practical course will focus on the therapist's ability to assess and treat sacroiliac joint stiffness. The therapist will learn the biomechanics of the region with particular emphasis on how to assess this clinically. Techniques taught will include joint movement assessment, manual mobilizations and muscle energy techniques. Also learn evidence based pain provocation tests which will help you rule in or out the sacroiliac joint as the source of pain. This course is designed to challenge the therapist's clinical reasoning skills, and the knowledge gained will be easy to apply to clinical practice right away.
